

Community Group Leader Commitment

God is raising a new temple, and has called you to build it. As a community group leader at Union, you are on the front lines of this construction project, making disciples who make disciples. These disciples are living stones of the new temple, founded on Christ the cornerstone. Your work rests on a solid foundation and will redound to your credit for all eternity (1 Thess. 2:19–20).

Goals of a Community Group

The main goal is for the group to become more Christlike. We become like him by doing what he did. Jesus Christ made new disciples, taught them to love God and one another, and sent them out to make more disciples in the power of his Spirit. The three subgoals of a community group are to imitate Christ accordingly.

- **Evangelism:** Share the gospel, bringing unchurched people from the kingdom of darkness into the kingdom of light
- **Friendship:** Grow in the knowledge and love of God and each other (forgiving one another, encouraging one another, and so on)
- **Multiplication:** Raise up apprentice leaders, sending them out to start new groups when they're equipped to do so
